The Ottoman Imperial Ceremony. Between the Official and the Private Dimensions.

The study proposes to make a brief analysis of the customs and traditions used in the ceremonies of the Ottoman Imperial Court. The study focuses on the differentiation of ceremonial types, from official ones to those with daily valences, selecting, presenting and explaining the important moments and their importance from a social, diplomatic, military point of view. All these scientific analyzes were carried out taking into account the tradition, custom, laws and religious practices in operation at the Ottoman gate, and of course, with reference to the ensemble of historical values of the Turkish ancestral background.
