4. General quality indicators of scientific production

I am an Associate Professor at Complutense University of Madrid. My scientific production has been disseminated into 75 articles (71 in JCR), 6 book chapters and 1 book. 36 of my publications in JCR journals (> 50%) are in the Q1 of their respective fields, and more than 88% (63 publications) have been published in Q1 or Q2 journals. My H-index is 20; sum of times cited in December 2024: 1,187 citations (source: Web of Science). I have participated in 17 funded research projects (7 as Principal Investigator, with a total collected value of 1,305,829.00 euros), in different countries (Spain, Belgium, UK) and collaborated with international renowned teams (Prof. J. Joormann, Yale University; Prof. Rudi De Raedt & Prof. Ernst Koster, Ghent University). From 2014 to 2017, I was a recipient of two prestigious postdoctoral FWO grants at Ghent University, with my 2 post-doctoral projects both ranked as 1st in Social Sciences in their corresponding calls. I was recipient of a competitive Grant for Attraction of Scientific Talent (Category: Senior Researchers), funded by the Community of Madrid, at Complutense University of Madrid (Spain) from 2018 to 2021, and was awarded with a Marie Skłodowska-Curie Individual Post-Doctoral Fellowship. From 2019 to 2022, I was Principal Investigator of a National Research Project funded by the Spanish Ministry of Science, and I am currently Principal Investigator of two other National Research Project for the period 2022-2025. Since 2018, I became a Principal Investigator and re-integrated into the Psychopathology of Affective and Psychotic Disorders Research Lab, where I currently lead my own group, E-Motion Lab (<https://www.ucm.es/e-motionlab-eng/>), with another Assistant Professor (Ivan Blanco Martínez) and two postdoctoral researchers and four PhD candidate students, all of them under my supervision. I have extensive experience in presenting my work at the most prestigious international conferences of my research field (e.g., APS, ICPS, ABCT, EABCT, WCBCT). I am author of > 150 peer-reviewed communications, and > 15 invited talks at international expert meetings. My skills for transfer of knowledge also refer to my teaching/ mentoring experience.

I was lecturer in BA programs and summer schools in the UCM from 2009 to 2011, after which I received an ANECA accreditation as Assistant Professor. During 2012, I worked as Assistant Professor in the UAM. From 2013 to 2017, I worked as Post-Doctoral Researcher at the prestigious Psychopathology and Affective Neuroscience lab (PANlab) of Ghent University (Belgium). Since 2018, I have been a Lecturer at both Graduate and Master educational programs at Complutense University of Madrid, being accredited by ANECA as Associate Professor in 2019. I have supervised 25 Master Theses and I have been member of evaluation committees of 6 PhD projects. I have codirected one Doctoral Thesis in Ghent University (PhD student: Malvika Godara, defended in August 2020) and I have supervised seven Doctoral Theses in Spanish Universities (PhD students: Angela Socastro, Teresa Boemo, Oscar Martin-Garcia, Ana M. Pacheco-Romero, Patricia Mecha, Fabiola Espinosa, María Vega-Sanz), three of them already defended, all graded with Summa Cum Laude. My capacity for transfer of knowledge is also highlighted by an active participation in peer-review processes for top-ranked journals (e.g., Clinical Psychological Science, Behaviour Research and Therapy, Emotion, Journal of Affective Disorders; 53 verified peer- reviews in WOS).
