

The Doctoral School of Geography (DSG) represents the graduate program (doctoral and postdoctoral studies) at the Faculty of Geography.

The research topics focus on climate changes detection and impact, extreme weather events, urban climate, urban/rural landscape morphology, dynamics and aesthetics, spatial planning, geography of settlements, tourism resources, sustainable development, and regional development models.

DSG offers professional conditions for research providing access to all research facilities existing in the Faculty of Geography and in the Babes-Bolyai University, offering research methodology trainings and summer schools, or research stages abroad. The doctoral thesis can be written in any of the major international languages (but mainly in English), on the basis of international double coordination or of the Doctor Europeo program
