## **General Admission Information**

## • Eligibility:

Only graduates holding a **Master's degree** or an **equivalent qualification** are eligible to participate in the doctoral admission exam. The **total number of transferable credits** (ECTS) accumulated from both **Bachelor's and Master's** study cycles must be **at least** 300.

According to the provisions of the **Higher Education Law no. 199/2023**, with its subsequent amendments, the **Bachelor's diploma** of graduates from long-duration higher education programs (prior to the Bologna system) is **equivalent to a Master's degree diploma** in that field.

Therefore, holders of such diplomas are **entitled to enroll** in doctoral studies **without having to complete a Master's program** (cycle II).

Admission into a doctoral program **is not conditioned** by the field in which the Bachelor's or Master's degree was obtained. However, the **total duration** of undergraduate and graduate studies must **accumulate at least 300 ECTS credits**.

• For current year Master's graduates:

Candidates who have passed their **dissertation exam** during the current academic year may submit, instead of the Master's diploma, a **graduation certificate** issued by the higher education institution.

This certificate must include the general GPA, the grades obtained throughout the study years, the total number of ECTS credits earned, the validity period, and a mention that the diploma has not yet been issued.

• For candidates with foreign studies:

It is mandatory to obtain a **recognition/equivalency certificate** for their **Bachelor's and Master's degrees** from the **Ministry of Education (ME)** and **CNRED** (National Center for Recognition and Equivalence of Diplomas).

The total number of transferable credits, according to the CNRED-recognized diplomas, must be at least 300 ECTS.

If the CNRED certificate is issued with an **electronic signature**, the **digital version** of the document must be submitted.

- Romanian citizens can personally apply for equivalency via CNRED's platform using a RoEID account: <u>https://cnred.edu.ro/echivalarea-studiilor-superioare-de-</u> <u>master-efectuate-in-strainatate-de-cetatenii-romani</u>
- EU citizens must submit their documents to ISD (Institute for Doctoral Studies) for the purpose of obtaining the recognition certificate, following CNRED's requirements.

Doctoral Positions Availability:

Candidates can consult the list of **available doctoral positions by faculty and advisor**, published by the **Institute for Doctoral Studies** both on-site and on its website, as well as on the websites of the individual doctoral schools.

## Application Process:

- Applications for doctoral admission are submitted **exclusively online**, via the official platform: <u>https://admittere.ubbcluj.ro</u>
- The candidate must create an account in the admissions platform using an **email address that is frequently checked**. Throughout the registration, admission, and confirmation process, the platform will generate and send **notifications and requests for feedback**, which the candidate must respond to promptly.
- During the registration period, as outlined in the Admission Calendar, the candidate will upload a set of required documents to the platform, as specified in the Required Documents section.
- General admission calendars, exam schedules, and other specific details related to the doctoral admission competition will be published on the websites of the doctoral schools.
